

Remembrance Sunday



100 years ago, Arthur Chick, aged 29, a father of two small children was killed during the 2nd Battle of Passchendaele on 28 October. Cecil Toms, aged 39, also a husband and father was killed on 30 October near Passchendaele in the mud of the Ypres Salient. He has no known grave. The names of both men are listed on our memorial plaque.

During the service at 6.30pm this evening, candles will be lit for those known personally to us and who we remember especially at this time.
