

## **Forthcoming musical events at Kingston URC**

On **Thursday 22 February at 12.30pm** concert pianist **Elia Stavrou** will be giving a lunchtime recital. He will be playing Chopin's Ballade no. 1 and Etude op.25 no. 1; Faure's Barcarolles nos. 1 and 10; Liszt's 'The fountains of the Villa d'Este'; and concluding with three preludes and 'I got rhythm' by Gershwin. "A range of moods from the fun and jazzy to the evocative and passionate" says Elia.

Highlights of the lunchtime recital on **Thursday 22 March at 12.30pm** will be organist Si Yeong Kim performing one of the greatest 19<sup>th</sup> century organ works - Liszt's Prelude and Fugue on BACH; pianists Sulhee Kim and Nigel Tunley playing Mendelssohn's own arrangement for piano duet of his ever-popular 'Hebrides' overture which was inspired by a visit to Fingal's Cave on the island of Staffa; and Shirley Noel (soprano) singing a selection of 20<sup>th</sup> century songs accompanied by Sulhee Kim.

The recitals last about 45 minutes and are free, with a retiring collection for KURC's Community Hub Project.
