Conductor **DAVID WARD** is a professor at the Royal College of Music, where he teaches piano, fortepiano and vocal repertoire. He has many years' experience of conducting professional and amateur orchestras including the New Sadlers' Wells Opera Company, the La Spiritata Orchestra (which he founded) and the Linden Baroque Orchestra.
